Site owners with multiple facilities should complete an implementation plan to indicate how all sites will be brought into the program. An individual assessment will be required for each site.

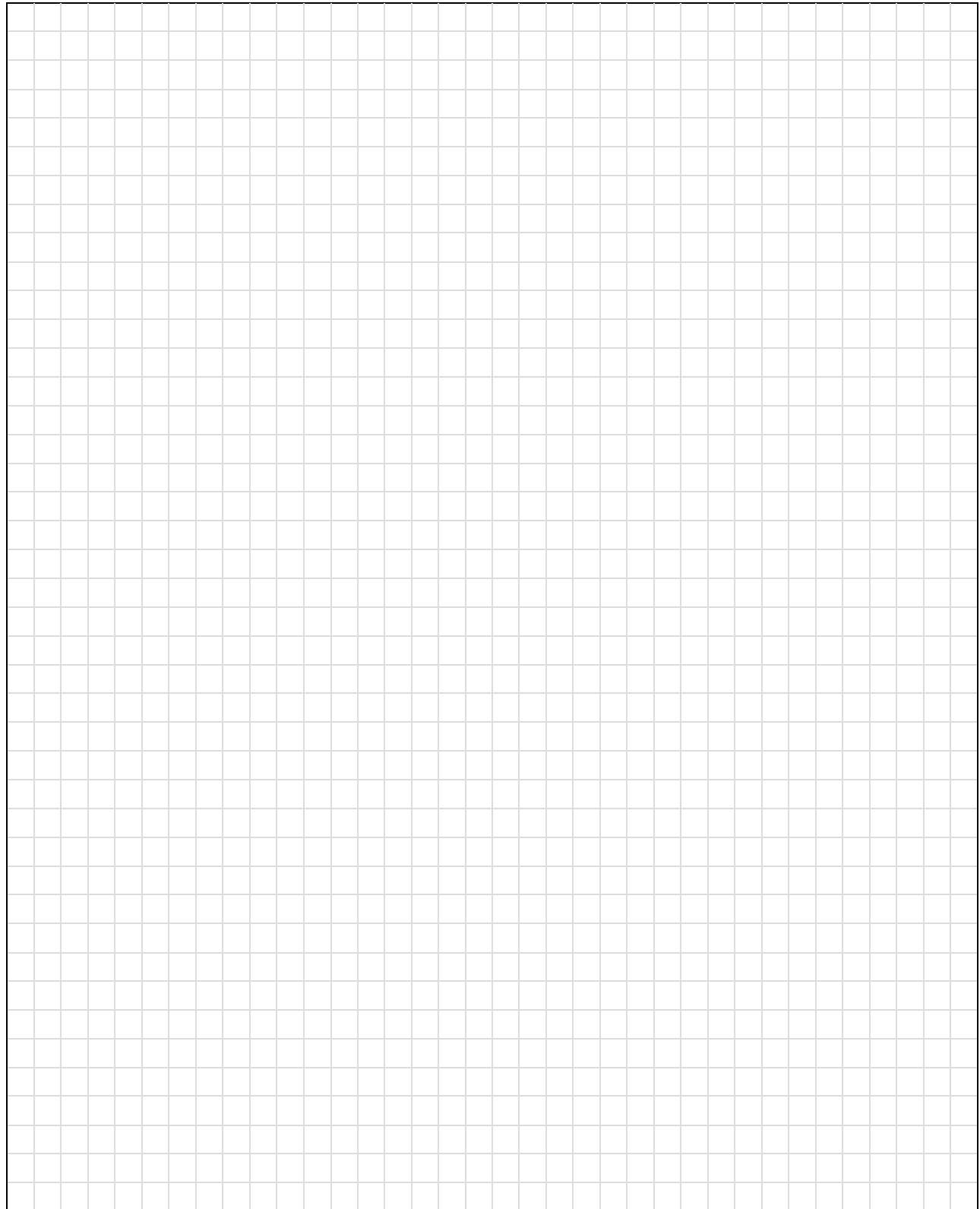
Contractors should work with clients to complete this section. When working with clients participating in the **smart about salt** program, contractors should ask to see related documents.
